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Purpose of the role	The purpose of the role is to lead and manage the girl experience delivery teams, to deliver girl experience aligned with the region strategy.
Who appoints this role?	Chief commissioner
Who supports this role?	Chief commissioner, deputy chief commissioner, guiding delivery group, nominated staff member
Length of appointment	3 years
Who can hold this role?	The lead volunteer for girl experience can be any adult over 18 years old.
Requirements	Must be (or willing to become) an active member of Girlguiding Midlands aged 18+). Some travel will be required for which reasonable travel expenses may be claimed.
What will I do in this role?	You will: • Lead and manage the girl experience delivery teams including up to 4 event volunteer leads. • Overall responsibility for delivery of girl-focussed events in the region. • Propose, and devise Girlguiding Midlands' region events, working with the region teams and 3rd party suppliers as applicable. • Ensure that all event risks are considered and managed effectively, including financial and reputational risk. • Propose and then manage the region girl experience budget, liaising with the region office and chief commissioner (or deputy) as required. • Demonstrate a working knowledge of and enthusiasm for creating and leading large-scale events and our international programme. • Be or be willing to become an expert in large scale event development and management and international programme delivery. • Use your expert knowledge to solve problems and promote the advantages of the girl experience offer in the guiding programme. • Support leaders to provide a safe girl-only space where girls and young women can discover their full potential through all areas of the programme. • Be available to provide ongoing support to the region by giving advice and answering specific queries in a timely manner, often by email. • Attend region level-specific meetings and events as required. • Administer any applicable training or qualifications in your area of responsibility. • Keep up to date with new resources and programme initiatives, and use and cascade information as appropriate, communicating with all relevant stakeholders. • Complete relevant training for the role and ensure the wider team's skills are up to date.
